☐ It's not necessary that you use the exact colors that I use during the class so improvise when you don't have the color and buy within your budget. I'll be using Winsor & Newton (Cotman and Professional) or Daniel Smith tubes in the following colors;

- PAYNE'S GREY (DEEP INKY BLUE ONE OF MY FAVS)
- NICKEL TITANATE YELLOW (PRIMARY YELLOW, OR LEMON YELLOW IS FINE)
- YELLOW OCHRE (ANOTHER ONE OF MY FAVS)
- PERMANENT ROSE (MY TOP COLOR FOR PAINTING PINK FLORALS)
 - CADMIUM RED
 - WINDSOR BLUE (PRIMARY BLUE, OR A PURE BLUE WORKS TOO)
 - OLIVE GREEN
 - SAP GREEN
 - BUFF TITANIUM (BLEACHED TITANIUM, OR A BEIGE, WORKS
 TOO)
 - PEACH (THIS SEEMS TO BE A COLOR THAT'S HARD TO FIND FOR SOME. TRY PLAYING AROUND WITH A MIX OF PERMANENT ROSE AND YELLOW/YELLOW OCHRE TO MIX A VERSION OF IT)
 - OPTIONAL FOR MIXING; BLACK AND WHITE

Some good quality brands to try are of course the Winsor & Newton Cotman (student line) and Professional, Daniel Smith watercolors and, I've heard good things about but haven't tried them myself; Sennelier, M. Graham Intermediate, Schmincke, Daler Rowney. * Note: feel free to use a dry pan set, or similar colors that you have access to.
